#### **LEADERSHIP OVERVIEW**

4. Why is it important for deaf people to assume leadership roles in the community and in the church? What are some ways deaf people can lead?
5. Give some examples of people in the Bible who were leaders. How did they lead? What would have happened if they had refused to be a leader? Who is the best model of leadership in the Bible?
6. Look at the life of Jesus and at His relationship with His disciples. What leadership qualities did Jesus possess? How did Jesus prepare His disciples to be leaders? How can you apply these same qualities to your own life so you can be a better leader?
