## Discussion Questions:

### THE BIG PICTURE

1. Read Matthew 28:18-20 and Acts 1:1-11. What is the purpose and goal of the Church? How has Jesus prepared His followers, both then and now, to achieve this goal?
2. Does every person have the same talents, skills and spiritual gifts? What are some of these gifts (see 1 Corinthians 12:4-13)? Is one gift more important than another? Why are many different people and gifts needed?
3. As a leader, do you find it difficult to let go of responsibilities and allow others to do it? Why is it important for leaders to equip others and then step back and let them take the lead? What are some ways to do this?
4. Why is it important for people to work together as a team for a common goal? What happens if a leader or another person in the group tries to force his ideas and wishes on others?
5. What is your purpose in the world and in the "big picture"? Are you using your gifts and skills effectively for God? Ask God to help you become a better worker on His team.
